

# Buyer > Agent Walk Through Checklist

## **GENERAL EXTERIOR**

- Walk around the home—check siding, roof, gutters, and foundation for damage
- Check for signs of water damage or grading issues (standing water, soft spots)
- Test all exterior lights
- Open and close gates, fences, and garage doors

#### **ENTRY & LIVING AREAS**

- Test doors and locks (entry doors, interior doors, and sliding doors)
- Inspect floors for damage, stains, or uneven sur faces
- Test light switches and ceiling fans
- Inspect for signs of leaks or water damage

### **KITCHEN**

- Test all appliances (stove, oven, fridge, dishwasher, microwave, garbage disposal)
- Run the sink—check water pressure, hot/cold water, and drainage
- Test range hood and exhaust fan

#### **BATHROOMS**

- Run faucets and shower—check pressure, drainage, and hot water
- Flush toilets—ensure proper function and no leaks
- Inspect under sinks for leaks or mold
- Test bathroom fans and ventilation

#### **BEDROOMS**

- Test doors, locks, and windows
- Inspect closets for space and proper door function
- Test electrical outlets and light switches

#### LAUNDRY ROOM

- Test washer and dryer hookups
- Run water in the sink (if applicable)
- Inspect for leaks or signs of water damage

#### **BASEMENT & ATTIC**

- Check for signs of moisture, mold, or water damage
- Inspect exposed pipes for leaks or rust
- Look for rodent or insect activity

#### **HVAC, PLUMBING & ELECTRICAL**

- Inspect water heater for leaks or rust
- Check breaker panel for proper labeling and function
- Test electrical outlets with a phone charger or tester
